Training Program Overview for Chapter Advisers and Student Members



Offered at all three LEAD sites will be in-depth training for both chapter advisers and student members of the National Honor Society®, National Junior Honor Society®. These are “must attend” sessions for NHS and NJHS and the only such training offered for honor societies this school year.

Adviser Training

Advisers can take advantage of workshop sessions geared towards their unique needs in chapter management such as reviewing selection procedures and policies to ensure that chapters are operating within the national guidelines and constitution. In addition, dealing with discipline and dismissal concerns, and valuable chapter operating tips will be presented.

CEU

By participating in the LEAD Conference, advisers may earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs). NASSP is a member of the International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET). LEAD Conferences are approved to provide 1.1 CEU credits for 11 hours of continuous educational training. The CEU certificate will be mailed to qualified applicants following the conference. Check with your school district to see if these credits can be applied toward your educational requirements.

Student Training

Students take part in workshops designed in areas such as service project ideas, fundraising, teambuilding and goal setting. In addition, sessions will be presented on getting organized, tips on officer duties, project planning and other leadership skills for successful NHS and NJHS members.

Registration

You must register to attend the LEAD Conference in order to take advantage of these highly valuable NHS & NJHS workshop sessions. Once you are registered, individual workshop sign up is not required. Check the final schedule of events to find out when NHS & NJHS workshops will be presented.
